Cookies are small text files that may be placed on your device when you interact with online services, which help the services remember information about your visit and interactions.

Emet cares deeply about user privacy and transparency; this document describes what kinds of cookies Emet uses.

Emet-specific Cookies

Emet itself doesn't use its own specific cookies.

Third-Party Cookies

Third-party cookies are cookies from a domain different from the domain of the website you are visiting. Similar technologies, such as pixels, web beacons, or local storage, can also be used for these purposes. We use "cookies" to refer to cookies and similar technologies.

The Emet platform uses limited third-party cookies (those from other web technology companies separate from us). They allow us to authenticate users or enable specific features within the app.

Managing cookies

Your web browser may allow you to delete and disable cookies. If you choose to disable cookies, you will not be able to access the Emet Earn platform as a registered user, as some cookies are required to login to Emet Earn.
